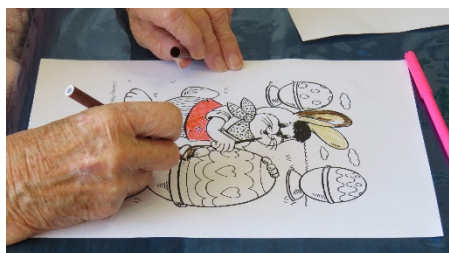
Due to the upcoming Public Holidays we are closed on the following days:
